

Diamond Canyon Student Athlete Character Expectations

At Diamond Canyon our student athletes are expected to be leaders in the classroom, striving to "Pursue Victory with Honor" according to the Six Pillars of Character: trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring and good citizenship. All coaches expect our players to be the school's student leaders and set examples for others to follow.

In the event that a student athlete fails to adhere to these character guidelines the consequences could be but are not limited to:

Office Referral	Consequence
One Office Referral	Benched from 1 practice
Two Office Referrals	Benched from 1 game
Three Office Referrals	Benched from 1 game; possible removal from team

^{**} In the event that a player is benched from a practice or game, they are still expected to be in attendance but they will not be allowed to participate. Administration and Athletic Director discretion may also be used when deciding the consequence of the referral.**

These character guidelines are in addition to what is laid out in the DVUSD Athletic Handbook.

- By not following the student code of conduct, I risk the chance of being removed from the team.
